## **Preceptorship Network Development 2017-2018**

## Aim

Develop and deliver a quality preceptorship Toolkit for Northwest NHS Trusts.

## **Objectives**

- Establish a core network of 10-12 members who will maintain and develop the Preceptorship Toolkit. The core network will meet every two months, initially at HEE and subsequently at locations around the Network footprint (TBC).
- Set up a virtual network of multi-disciplinary members who have an interest in the Preceptorship Toolkit, to work in collaboration and co-production with the Board. This will be a wide online network that co-produces content for the Toolkit, provides feedback and local intelligence, and evaluates the updated Toolkit when it goes live.
- Ensure the core network is multidisciplinary across the North West and has representation from mental Health Trusts, Community Trusts and Primary Care Trusts.
- Share multi-professional good practice (and develop where necessary) and challenges through the Network Board and wider virtual network, utilising the Toolkit to deliver the outputs.
- Develop a communications strategy including events, online forum, blogs and links to other networks as appropriate.
- Assume responsibility for the ongoing development and maintenance of the Preceptorship Toolkit moving forward.
