

Student feedback

I have loved getting to know the wider team within the Nutrition and Dietetics Department, particularly to see how the Dietetic Associate Practitioners support and develop the service we all work to deliver

I was surprised to find out how varied the Dietetic Associate
Practitioner's role can be, and being given the opportunity to shadow presentations delivered by DAPs to other local services was eye opening in seeing how influential nutritional awareness can be in service outcomes. This allowed me a further understanding of how the department runs as a whole, and a better perspective on the importance of MDT working







Student feedback

Student training alongside a DA was incredibly beneficial, particularly on placement B as it allowed for a good overview of the process from referral to discharge. I felt fully supported throughout in terms of how to gather information, communicate with patients and documentation. It provided me with knowledge of the role and scope of practice of a DA which will be very helpful as a newly qualified band 5 dietitian. Bev was encouraging and professional throughout and provided clear constructive feedback on how to improve for future practice.

Working with DAPs have also given me a great insight into using the administrative systems, as well as getting to know the processes behind organising visits, calls, clinics and other admin events. Getting to know the care pathway a patient follows before and after a consultation helps me to relate better to what their experience have and will be.







Student feedback

During my time on placement, Bev was one of my supervisors. I shadowed her during care home visits, and we delivered training for healthcare staff in care homes.

Placement can be very daunting for a student, but I felt completely at ease with Bev as she was very approachable. As a supervisor, she gave me the autonomy I needed while providing me with well-thought-out and constructive feedback. I recall feeling particularly entrusted to lead a meeting with a chef from one of the care homes, which motivated me and gave me confidence.

Bev was an exceptional supervisor; she was friendly, supportive, and incredibly knowledgeable. She was a wonderful mentor, and I learned a lot from her about supplements, nutrition support, care homes, and other related topics.
